## PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Subject: To regularize M.Sc., Nursing Course of The Karnataka College of Nursing, Bangalore.

Read: Govt. Order No. ACA/NS-134/O-95/2008-09, Dated: 23.05.2008.

#### Preamble:

The Karnataka College of Nursing, Bangalore has been allowed as per the letter cited above to regularize from the academic year 2008-09 for the commencement of M.Sc. Nursing in Community Health, Medical Surgical, O.B.G., Paediatric and Psychiatric Nursing Courses with a limitation of 5 seats of admission in each under the rule 45(2) of 1994 of the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, after the thorough study on the investigative report on the opinion of the Academic Council and Syndicate, Recommending to the Government made herein.

After a careful perusal of all the concerned documents, the Karnataka College of Nursing, Bangalore has been permitted to regularize M.Sc. Nursing in Community Health, Medical Surgical, O.B.G., Paediatric and Psychiatric Nursing with a limitation of 5 seats of admission in each course during the 2008-89, the Government has passed the following Order.

# GOVT. ORDER NO. H&FWS 227 MPS 2008, BANGALORE, DATED 30.06.2008

While exercising its power under Rule 45(5) of 1994, the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences has permitted The Karnataka College of Nursing, Bangalore to commence M.Sc. Nursing in Community Health, Medical Surgical, O.B.G., Paediatric and Psychiatric Nursing Courses with a limitation of 5 seats of admission in each course during the year 2008-09, the government has recommended the regularization of the above courses under the following terms and conditions:

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Karnataka College of Nursing, Bangalore has to part with 25% of quota to the Government for the distribution of seats.
- 2. Permission has to be obtained by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences to commence the course in M.Sc. Nursing.
- 3. It is mandatory to obtain permission under the rule 13 of 1947 follow the rules and regulations laid by the Indian Nursing Council. Also must possess basic facilities The Karnataka Nursing Council and Indian Nursing Council as per the terms and conditions laid under the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences.
- 4. Admission of the students must be made only after regulization of the course under no circumstances, there should not be any additional admission of the students of the course. In case of any violation of rules, the students are forbidden for the admission and the educational institution would be derecognized and criminal action would be initiated against the

- 6. As per the direction of Indian Nursing Council is required to possess its own hospital within a period of 5 years, failing which the regularization would be withdrawn.
- 7. Admission and selection of the students during the year 2003 in Karnataka Nursing, Pharmacy and Physiotherapy, M.Sc. Nursing, M.T.P and M.Pharma courses must be strictly in accordance with the ratio of Government and Management quota.
- 8. The above college remains permanently unaided institution under the terms and conditions as such they do not get any aid or financial assistance by the Government.
- 9. In case of any violation of the terms and conditions mentioned above, the sanction of regularization of the college under the Rule 48 of 1994 of Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore would be withdrawn.
